

It's Your Responsibility . . . Get Your Child Screened!



Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child is required to participate in the Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener (FLKRS) in the first 30 days of kindergarten. All kindergarten students who attend kindergarten in the public schools will automatically be screened. **If your child will attend kindergarten in a non-public school, you are responsible for having your child screened. Be sure to check with your child's kindergarten school to make sure your child is screened.**



The Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener is based upon the Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards for Four-Year-Olds (2011). The results of this screening:

- provide valuable information about your child's readiness for kindergarten
- help teachers develop lesson plans to meet each child's individual needs
- will also be used to calculate a readiness rate each year for private and public school providers of the VPK Education Program.

If you have any questions about the screening process, **please contact the school that your child will be attending for kindergarten.** We are all working together to make sure that your child's kindergarten experience is successful.
